Master of Science in Accounting:

This ACBSP-accredited program offers evening, accelerated and online courses, and is designed to meet the 150-hour CPA certificate requirement for CPA licensure.

Master of Arts in Communication:

Available in one- and two-year formats, this program immerses you in modern media and prepares you to thrive in a high-stakes communication landscape.

Master of Science in Clinical Mental Health Counseling:

Gain specialized skills and knowledge to address a wide spectrum of mental health disorders and needs. Students may complete the program in two years (full-time) or four years (part-time).

Master of Arts in Teaching:

Designed for aspiring teachers with a bachelor's degree in any field, the MAT prepares you for the initial Pennsylvania teaching certification in just 15 months.

Master of Science in Human Resources Management:

Tailored for future HR professionals and business leaders alike, the M.S. HRM has three concentrations: administration, training and development, or strategic management and leadership.

Master of Science in Information Systems:

Created to meet the growing need for talented information architects and managers, the M.S. IS can be completed in as little as one year.

Master of Science in Nursing:

Available in three concentrations (Clinical Nurse Lead, Nursing Administration and Nursing Education), the MSN is available entirely online, making it ideal for working nurses.

Doctor of Nurse Anesthesia Practice:

Offered in both entry-level and completion-level programs, the DNAP will prepare you for leadership positions in health care policy, administration and education.
